**UMM Retreat.** The District United Methodist Men will hold a weekend retreat at the West River Center from Friday evening, February 8 to Sunday morning, February 10. An exciting agenda is planned. It will include presentations by Rev. Evan Young, district superintendent, and Ron Metzler of the Motorcycle Ministry; entertainment by Rev. Jerry Colbert and his Singing and Praying Band; small group discussions on the role of men as breadwinners, parents, spiritual leaders, community workers, prayer warriors and disciples; recreational activities; and prayer time and communion. The cost, which will include all meals and accommodations, is \$125. Several members of Eastport United Methodist Men will be attending, and others are encouraged to join us. **Lenten Study.** What does it mean to be a Christian today? In this time of change and conflict within the church, what is most central to an authentic Christianity and Christian life? These questions will be the focus of a six-week Lenten Study to be held Wednesdays from February 13 to March 20 in the chapel. Day and evening classes are planned: from 10:15 to 11:45 a.m. followed by a short worship service with communion and table fellowship, and, if there is sufficient interest, from 6:45 to 8:15 p.m. The study will be based on Marcus Borg's thought-provoking book, *The Heart of Christianity: Rediscovering a Life of Faith*. Borg is distinguished professor of religion and culture at Oregon State University and the author of several best-selling books about Jesus. Prepare for lots of interesting discussion! **You must sign up no later than February 10 on the board in the fellowship hall.** The cost of the book is \$12 but scholarships are available.
