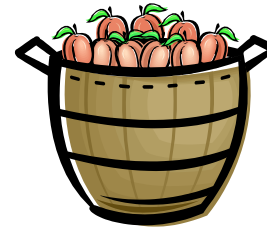

EUMC will be hosting a Care for Creation Camp at the church for children in kindergarten through 3rd grade, August 14 to 18, from 9 a.m. to 12 noon daily. There will be games, crafts, songs, snacks and hands-on activities each day led by church member and science teacher Jennifer Smith and Pastor Michelle. We are reaching out to our homework club students and inviting them to attend, but would welcome your child as well. 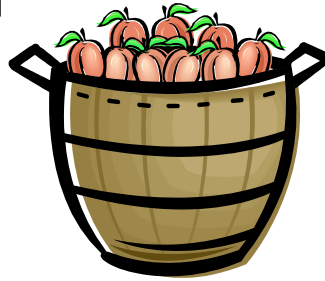
