The Rev. Laura Norvell, native of the Chicago area, is a graduate of Indiana University with a Bachelor of Arts degree in English with minors in economics and political science and a Master of Divinity degree from Wesley Theological Seminary. She has worked as development professional in higher education, religion and social service since 1991, transitioning to Maryland in 2000, with a brief break for being a full-time classroom volunteer and PTA president

while her children were small. As a provisional elder in the Baltimore-Washington Annual Conference of The United Methodist Church, she serves in extension ministry as vice president for development at Wesley Theological Seminary. Most recently she also served as minister of discipleship at Liberty Grove United Methodist Church in Burtonsville, MD. Deeply rooted in a belief in the grace and gifts given all of God's children, her call is to build relationships among people so that leaders are raised up to nurture, grow and lead the body of Christ in making disciples for the transformation of the world.

Laura is married to the Rev. Matt Norvell who is the chaplain for the Children's Center at Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore. She has three children – Brook (22), Emma (19) and Paige (18) – all of whom will be college students this fall! Her next great adventures in ministry include a major fundraising campaign for Wesley, teaching and preaching in local churches throughout the annual conference, and pursuing a Doctor of Ministry focused on transformative leadership in the Wesleyan tradition in Cambridge, England.
