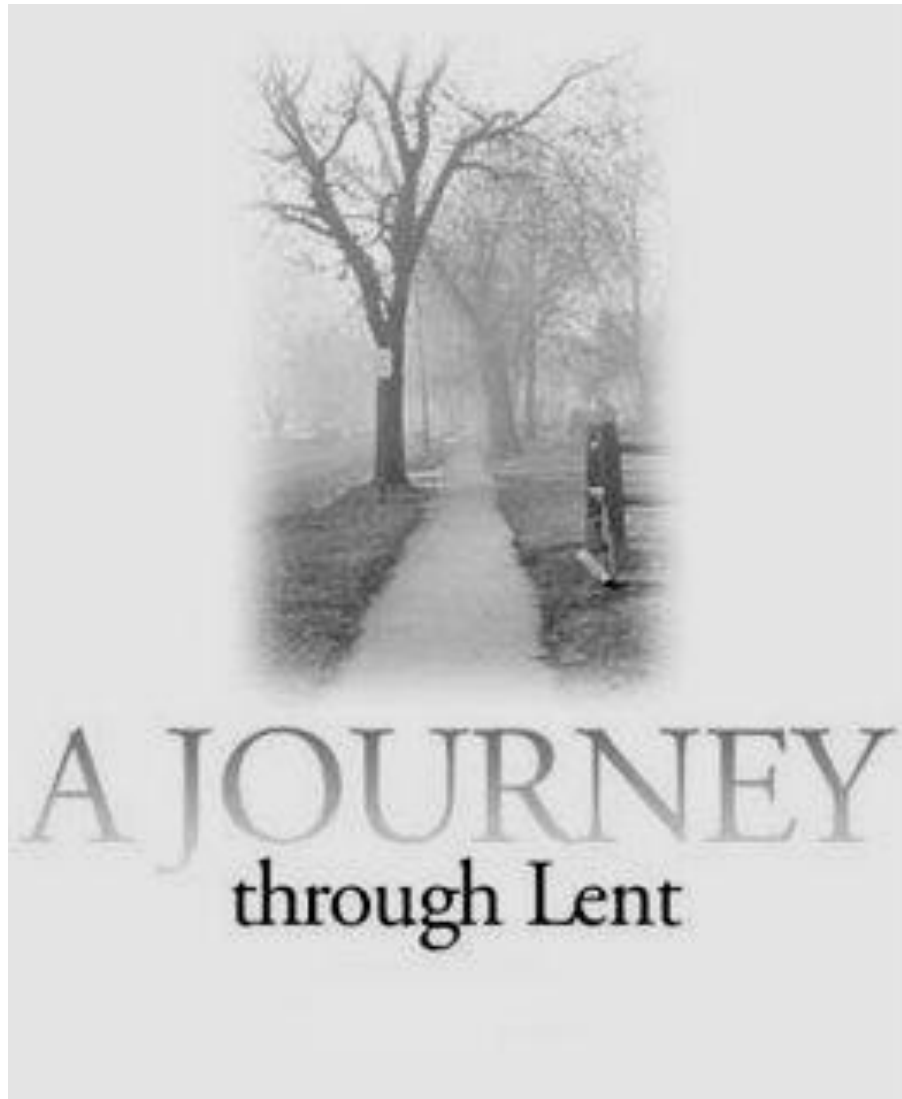

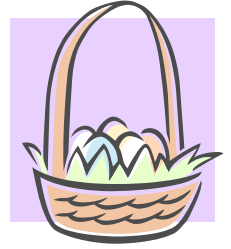
Next Sunday – this is important – please read carefully! As you read in the March newsletter, our worship service next Sunday will be at First Presbyterian Church on Duke of Gloucester Street. Services are at



8:30 and 11:00 a.m. – the Easter Cantata will be presented at both. Our choir will join with theirs; JoAnn Kulesza will direct and Dr. Robert Muckenfuss will play the organ. Godly Play (Sunday School) is offered during both services – one classroom for 4-year olds through kindergarten, and one for first and second graders. A nursery is also provided. Free validated parking is available at the Hillman Garage right across the street from First Presbyterian. Meeting at EUMC and carpooling with other members is suggested to ease the parking issue. Those who can't deal with downtown parking and would like a ride from our church to First Presbyterian are asked to sign up with Eunice Corse in Fellowship Hall today.

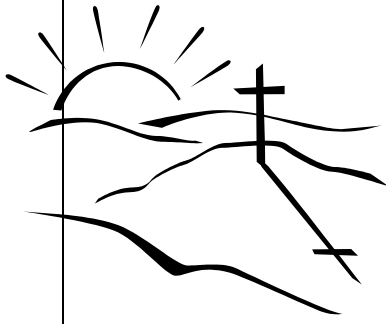
