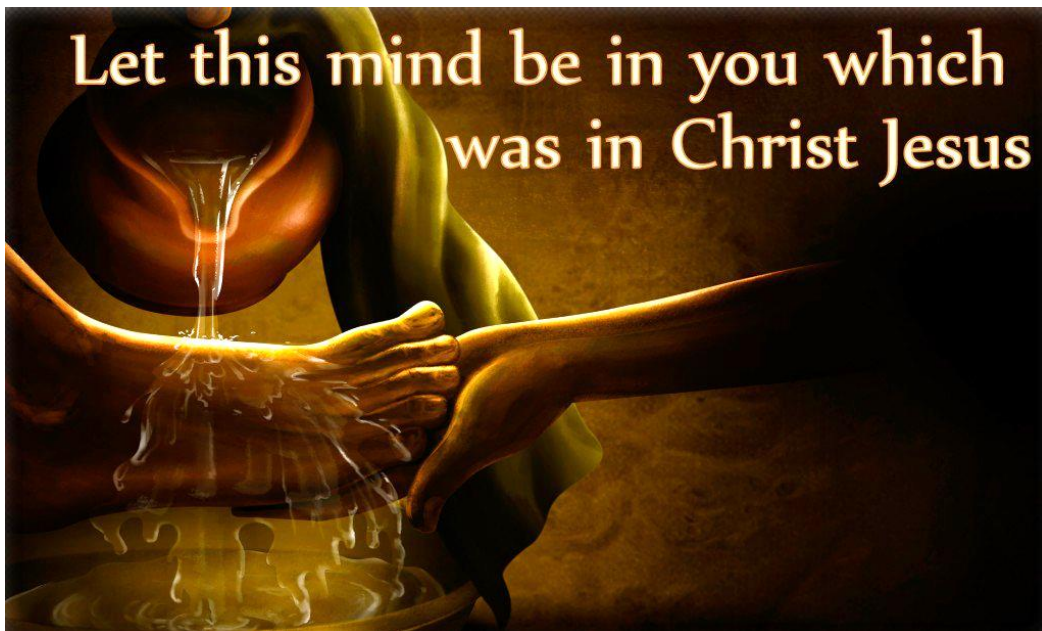

Dinner begins at 6pm. We adjourn at 8pm.

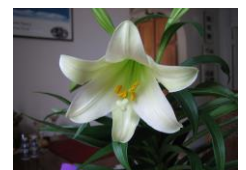
