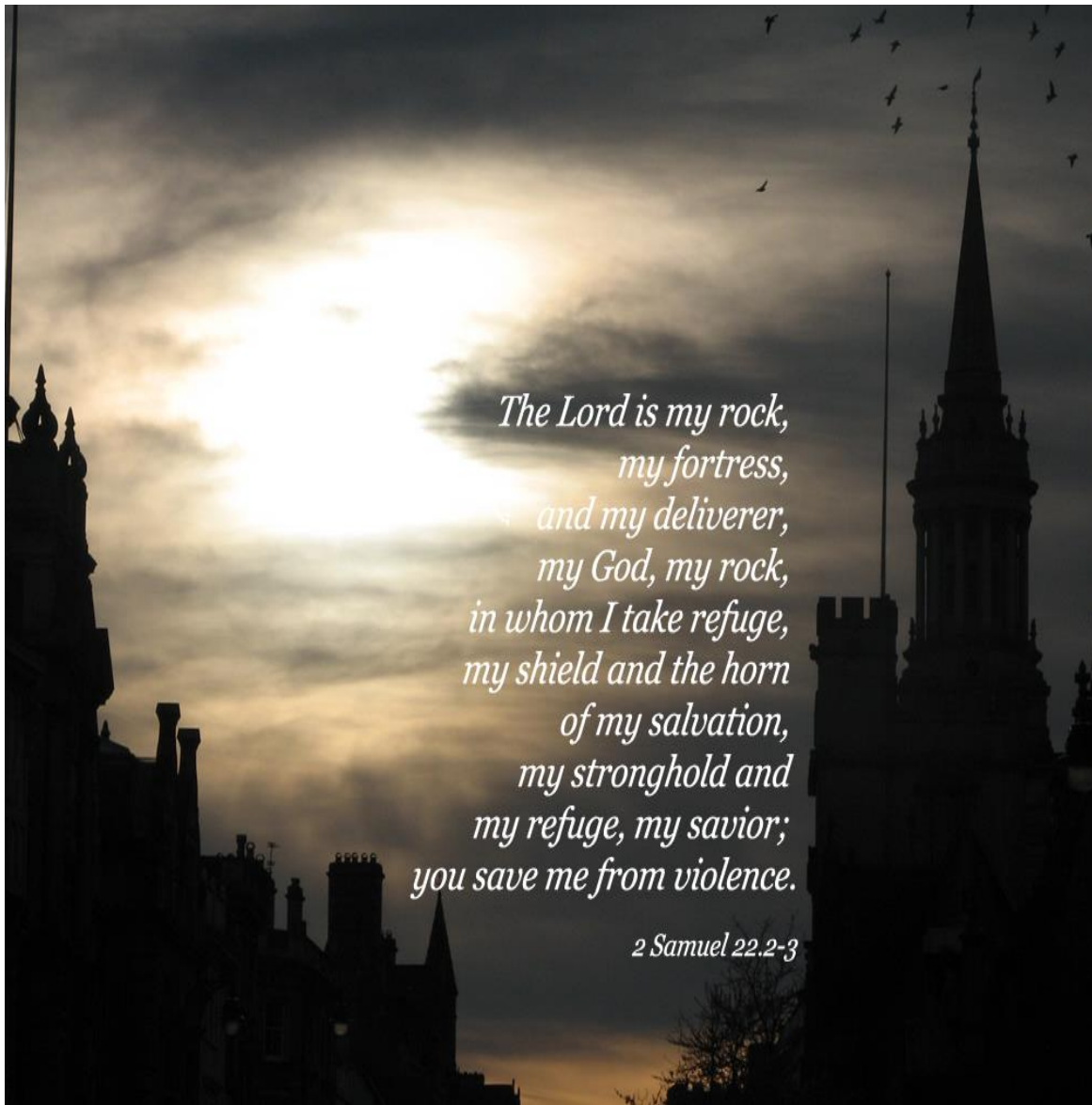

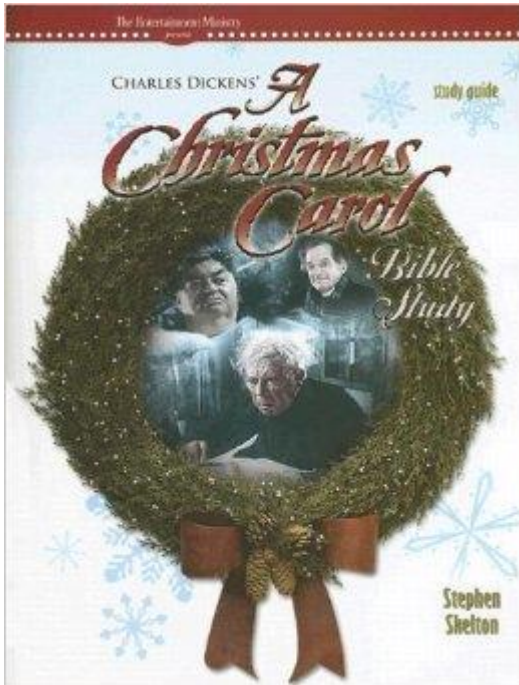


Gracious Greetings -Thursday, November 21 1:30 p.m. Christmas card making for our Timothy House friends! Everyone is welcome to help make cards.
